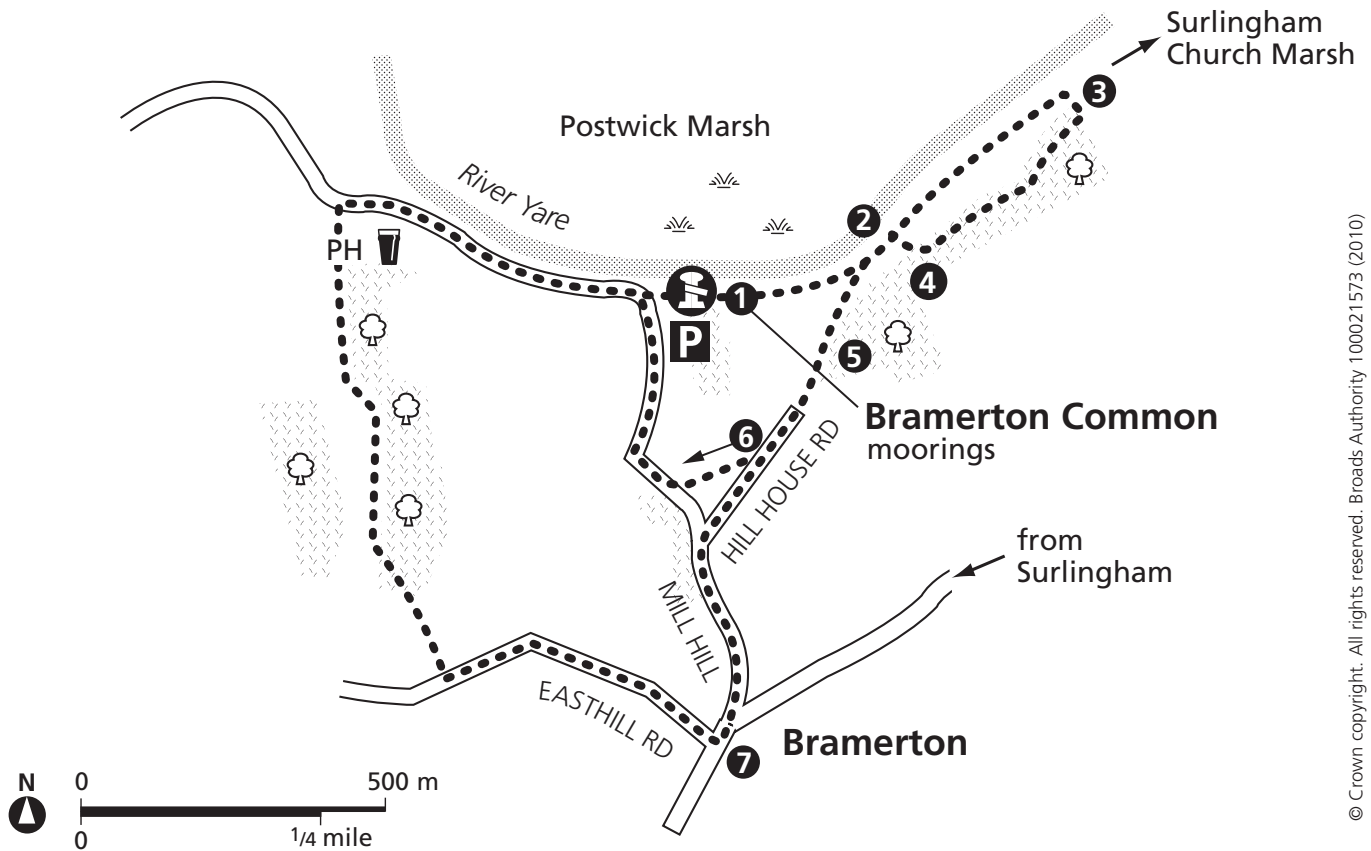


## Broads Walks: Bramerton Riverside Walks

1½ miles (2.5 km) 3 miles (4.8km) 1 – 1½ hours

### Route

- 1 Walk across the open grass of Bramerton Common and carry on along the narrow footpath behind the private moorings.
- 2 Then bear left and join the riverbank path.
- 3 Turn right and follow the path over the bridge, then turn right again.  
For a longer walk turn left and it's about a 10 minute walk to reach the RSPB's Surlingham Church Marsh nature reserve. Dogs on leads are allowed there.
- 4 Turn right towards the river, then left, retracing your steps.
- 5 Go straight ahead up the steep hill towards some cottages. Continue along Hill House Road.
- 6 For the shorter walk turn right along a wooded footpath running behind some old cottages and right again down the road leading back to the common. For the longer walk continue along Hill House Road and then turn left along Mill Hill.
- 7 Turn right on to Surlingham Lane and then immediately right again down Easthill Lane. After about half a mile turn right down a byway, and right again at the bottom, past the pub, to return to the start.
