Broads Walks: Coltishall to Horstead

Broads Walks: Coltishall to Horstead 6 miles (9 km) $3 - 3^{1/2}$ hours

Route

- 1 Walk across the common towards the pubs or follow the footpath by the road.
- 2 Follow the footpath by the main road towards Coltishall. Cross the road with care after the church to use the footpath and recross to the left hand side opposite the café.
- **3** At the car park in front of the hall cross the green to the wooden footbridge. Turn left and follow the path by the river to Horstead Lock. Cross the bridge, turn left and then bear right towards Horstead Mill.
- 4 Cross the bridge over the mill pool to the car park and turn right to walk upstream on the opposite bank of the river.
- 5 Cross the main road with care. Turn right and cross the footbridge over the river, then turn left through a gate and follow the footpath by the river. Continue until you reach Little Hautbois Road at Mayton Bridge.

- 6 Turn right along the road and continue until you reach the road junction by the railway bridge. Cross the main road, turn right and after about 25m go down the steps on the left to join the Bure Valley Walk which runs parallel to the Bure Valley Railway. Turn right and walk beside the railway, continuing past Coltishall Station.
- 7 Continue until you pass farm buildings on the right and reach steps down to a road just before a bridge (number 1295). Turn right along the road (through the hamlet of St James) and carry on until the road bends sharply left. Leave the road and follow the footpath that runs to the left in front of you. It will take you back to the main road in Coltishall, opposite the pubs. Cross the road, turn left and retrace your steps to the starting point.
